Cosco Shipping Specialized Carriers starts new weekly BRICS Express service to the eastern coast of South America.

The new multipurpose service links major Chinese ports with **Brazil**.

<u>Cosco Shipping</u> said that by capitalising on the scale advantages of multi-purpose pulp carriers, the service aims to address the urgent shipping demands of customers along South America's eastern coast, establishing a maritime express route that fosters bilateral trade between <u>China</u> and this region.

To ensure reliable capacity for the BRICS Express, Cosco Shipping Specialised Carriers has deployed over 40 large multipurpose pulp vessels, including 20 core 77,000 dwt ships and 22 back up 62,000 dwt vessels.

These vessels run scheduled weekly services between key Chinese ports -Qingdao, Taicang, Ningbo, Nanshaand major Brazilian ports -Salvador, Vitória, Sepetiba-, achieving on-time departures and deliveries with transit times as fast as 30 days
